AMBULATORY BLOOD PRESSURE MONITORING

This machine has been fitted to record your blood pressure for the period of time you are wearing it.

As has been explained to you by our nurse, your BP will be taken automatically every hour throughout the day until 10pm when it will be taken second hourly until 6am. It will then resume hourly readings until it is removed. At times the machine may take a second reading within the hour. This is quite normal as it is checking the last reading was correct. If it continues to repeat the readings more frequently please call the surgery and speak to one of the nurses.

While you are wearing the monitor, we ask you to complete the diary on the back of this sheet. The ideal time to do this is when your BP has just been taken. The diary will help the Dr when he is reporting on the readings as some movements/emotions may cause changes in your BP readings.

Please make sure you include the diary when you return the monitor the next day, even if you have not written much as it has all your details on the sheet.

NB: DO NOT GET THIS MACHINE WET. AVOID DROPPING THE MACHINE OR ANY HEAVY KNOCKS
